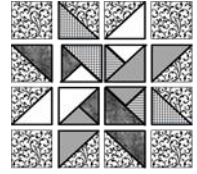


MARCH 2014 BLOCK OF THE MONTH

Woven Sawtooth
12-½" (12" Finished)



NOTE: Break out your Crayolas and Color Pencils again!

Focal Fabric.....	8 ea	4" Squares	and	8 ea	3 ½" Squares
Blue Batik Background Fabric.....	3 ea	4" Squares	and	1 ea	5 ¼" Square
Orange Accent Fabric.....	3 ea	4" Squares	and	1 ea	5 ¼" Square
Red Accent Fabric.....	3 ea	4" Squares	and	1 ea	5 ¼" Square
Green Accent Fabric	3 ea	4" Squares	and	1 ea	5 ¼" Square

(1) Cut ALL 5 ¼" Squares

- Cut the 5 ¼" Squares (**Blue, Orange, Red** and **Green** fabric) diagonally in **both** directions (make 4 triangles for each color)

(2) Assemble One Half of Units – 2 Each

- Piece the small triangles together, matching colors per drawing
- Press the **Red/Green** to the Right,
- Press all others to the Left

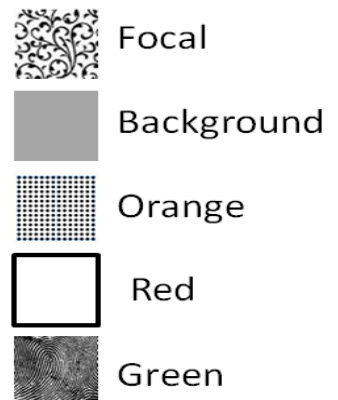
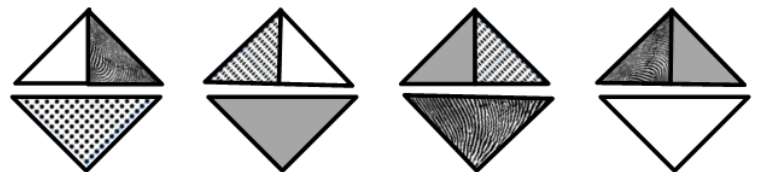


(3) Cut ONE of Each 4" Square

- Cut 1 ea **Blue**, 1 ea **Orange**, 1 ea **Red** and 1 ea **Green** square on the diagonal once to make 2 triangles for each color, use in Step 4.

(4) Combine Triangles

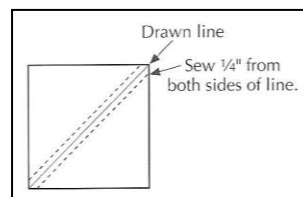
- Add the half 4" square (Step 3) to each unit from Step 3.
- Match the **Orange, Red, Green** and **Blue Batik** triangles per drawing – (**Make 2 each**).
- Press to larger half
- Square up to 3 ½"

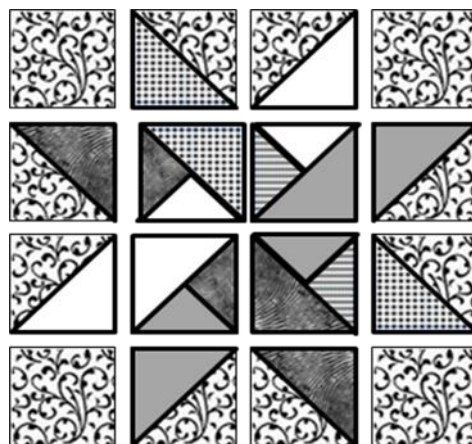
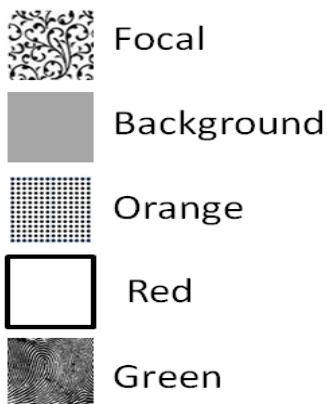
(5) Make 16 HST's

- With 8 each 4" squares of **Focal** fabric and the 2 remaining 4" squares of **Blue, Orange, Red** and **Green** fabric, make 16 HST's.
- Press **Focal /Blue Batik** towards **Focal**
- Press **Focal/Red** towards **Red**
- Press **Orange/Focal** towards **Focal**
- Press **Green/Focal** towards **Green**
- Square up to 3 1/2"

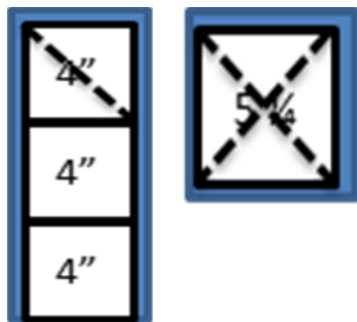
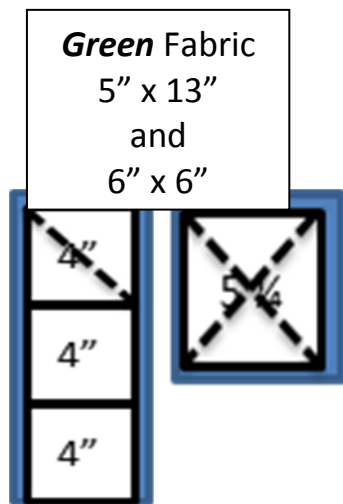
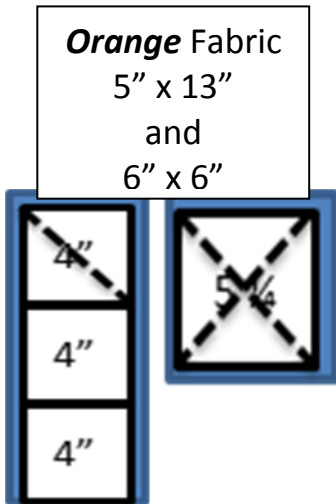
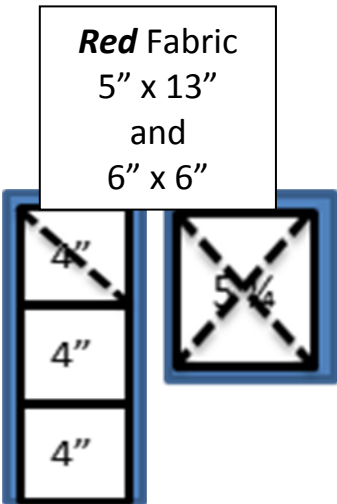
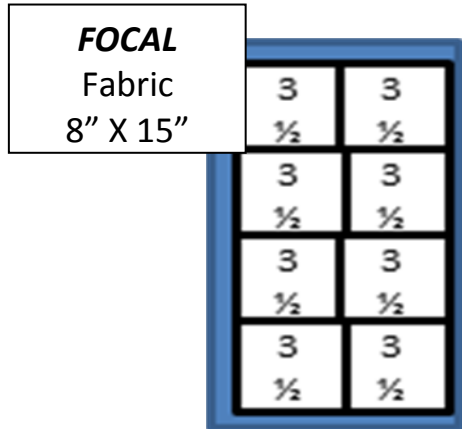
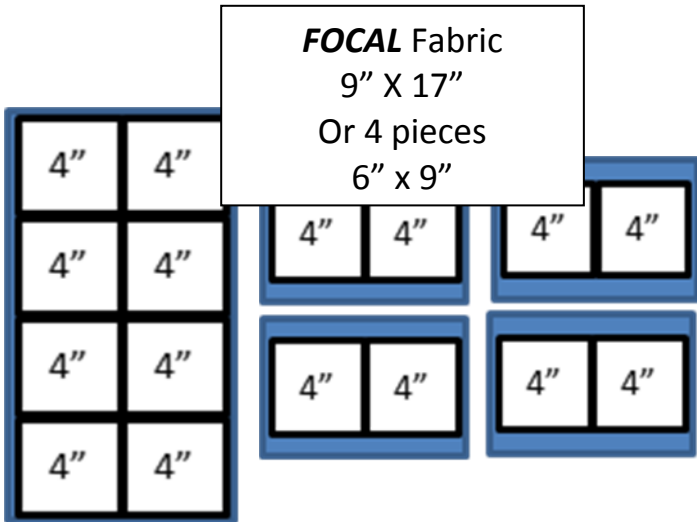


(5) ASSEMBLE and Sew Both BLOCKS

- Lay out units as shown
- Sew rows, alternating direction of pressing
- Join rows press as desired
