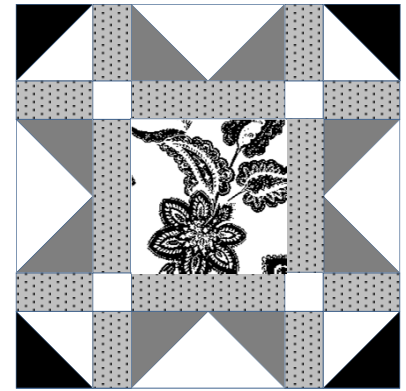


August 2014 Block of the Month – Divided Sawtooth

Instructions make two 10 ½" blocks (10" finished)



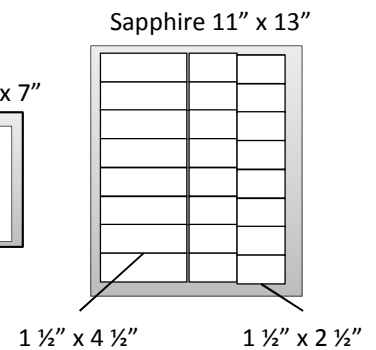
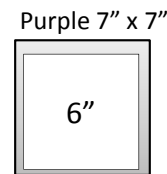
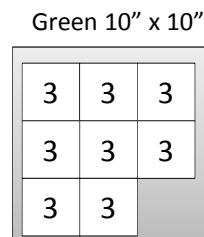
Your kit should include:

- One Purple 7" square
- One Green 10" square
- One Sapphire 11" x 13" rectangle

Cutting Instructions:

Focal	Two 4 ½" squares
Cream	One 6" square Two 5 ½" squares Eight 1 ½" squares
Green	Eight 3" squares
Purple	One 6" square
Sapphire	Eight 1 ½" x 4 ½" rec. Sixteen 1 ½" x 2 ½" rec.

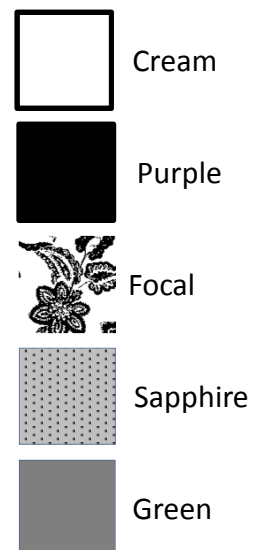
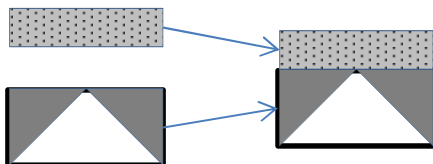


1. Make Eight Cream & Purple HST

- Follow the HST technique sheet
- Use cream & purple 6" squares
- Press toward Purple
- Square up HST to 2 ½"

2. Make Eight Cream & Green Flying Geese

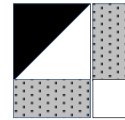
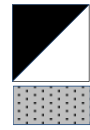
- Follow the No-Waste Flying Geese technique sheet (make two sets)
- Use 5 ½" cream square & 3" green squares
- Trim geese to 4 ½" x 2 ½"
- Attach 1 ½" x 4 ½" sapphire rectangle to each of the geese

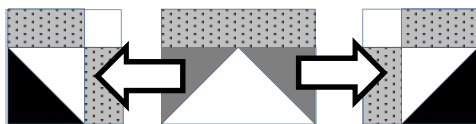
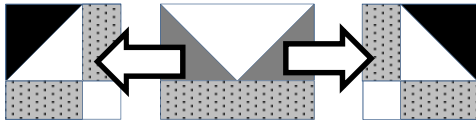
3. Assemble Corner Units

- Stitch a 1 ½" x 2 ½" sapphire rectangle to one CREAM side of a cream/purple HST
- Press toward the sapphire
- Stitch a cream 1 ½" square to the short end of the remaining eight 1 ½" x 2 ½" sapphire rectangles
- Press toward the sapphire
- Attach the two parts
- Press seams in opposite directions to "pop" the center



Assemble Blocks:

Sew rows 1-3 as shown, pressing in the direction of the arrows.



Join rows 1-3 together & press seams in opposite directions to "pop the centers."
