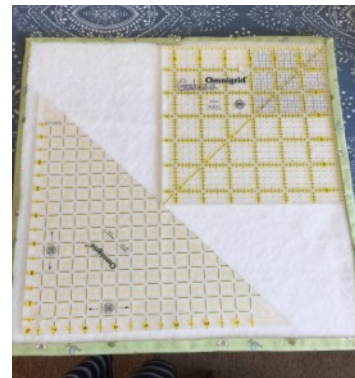


Mexican Star GVQG May 2020 BOM

This month's pattern comes from Eleanor Burns-Quilt in a Day.

I chose my colors from the Mexican Flag and am adding a picture of that here, so that you can choose similar colors so we can have unity among the blocks turned in when we meet again for someone to win!

Please use a strong red for the stripes. For the background, use a white. I chose a white on white print. For the two other colors, use a medium to dark green and a light to medium brown.





Here are a few photos to show some construction tips and tricks.

The two rulers show how to cut the 45 degree angle.

Photo 7 shows the overhang needed to get the proper fit of the pieces together.

Photo 8 shows the dog-ears that will need to be trimmed off after pressing.

The final picture shows the overhang of the red strips, if you like, you can trim the red strips even with the edges of the block, but **Please do not do the final trim up of the block-leave it at this point of construction!** *The person winning the blocks will want to do the final trim of all the blocks.*
